Dear Ms. Potten and Mr. Casas:

Re: Water Licence #MV2011L2-0004Snap Lake Mine De Beers Canada Inc. Drinking Water Aesthetic Objective Guideline Chloride Low Action Level Triggered

Please accept this letter as notice that the chloride concentrations at SNP 02-20e and SNP 02-20f were above 75 % of the Health Canada aesthetic objective (i.e.250 mg/L) based upon samples collected in March 2015. Therefore, the low action level in the Aquatic Effects Monitoring Plan related to drinking water was triggered (Table 1).

The proposed action as per the response framework is to notify stakeholders. As noted by De Beers in the February 25, 2015 letter regarding the exceedance of 75% of the aesthetic objective for TDS no further action is recommended at this time. De Beers has completed an environmental assessment and is undergoing a regulatory review of its application to remove the current water licence limit for whole-lake TDS, and replace with a higher, end-of-pipe TDS limit, as supported by studies of the effects of TDS on aquatic life in Snap Lake which conclude that higher TDS levels in Snap Lake will not result in harmful effects to the aquatic environment. This TDS EQC will regulate chloride. This course of action was agreed to by the Government of the Northwest Territories in



their response to the February 25, 2015 letter, noting: "ENR recommends that no action is required at this time. Action levels related to TDS within the Aquatic Effects Monitoring Plan will require confirmation or re-evaluation pending the outcome of the current regulatory process."

Results of all monitoring conducted in March under the SNP will be submitted as required, by April 30, 2015.
